- ◆ Riders competing for Seniors/Juniors event must possess an FEI ID while horses must be presented with an original FEI passport or an FEI approved National Passport with Recognition Card and with up to-date influenza vaccination record.
- ◆ **All Riders & Horses participating in any International competition must be registered with the FEI. See General Regulations, 23rd Edition Art. 113.3: "Any Athlete and/or any Horse who is not registered with the FEI shall be automatically disqualified."**
- ◆ At the Pre-ride Inspection please ensure that your horse is sufficiently warmed up before you bring it inside the vet gate. Any horse which will not permit examination or which is dangerous to the examiners shall be eliminated
- ◆ At the First Inspection - qualified riders will be presented with two identification cards, one will be fixed around the neck of the horse while the other should be kept with the rider and should be presented at the Gate during Arrival and Departure.
- ◆ The Identification cards around the neck of the horse are not to be removed under any circumstances other than under the jurisdiction of the Ground Jury Officials present at the venue.
- ◆ When Horse is sent out for re-inspection – the crew/groom/rider responsible must use the VET OUT gate ONLY and must present the horse with the fixed Identification card to the timekeeper.
- ◆ To do Re-inspection, the crew/groom/rider responsible must use the Re-inspection VET IN gate ONLY and must present the horse with the fixed Identification card to the timekeeper.
- ◆ Riders must wear hard type riding helmets with chin strap and shoes with heels.
- ◆ (Art.810) Horse with draw reins and French reins are forbidden. Whips and spurs are not permitted.
- ◆ Giving water or assistance of any kind from inside a car is forbidden. No crewing inside the vet gate.
- ◆ Not more than two persons and the rider will be permitted into the vet gate. Any horse retired after the start must be shown to an official Ride Veterinarian before it leaves the venue.
- ◆ Bottles of water will be given to the riders before departure for each stage from the village while presenting the departure paper to the Secretary.
- ◆ First inspection will take place on **Saturday, 13th Mar 2010 from 4.00 AM – 5.30 AM.**
- ◆ Time Limit : **7 Hours 50 Minutes** (Riders should finish within the time limit)
- ◆ Footwear without a heel only permitted when using caged stirrups or similar.
- ◆ During the First inspection, the weight of the riders will be taken and slash cards shall be distributed accordingly.
